

2020 City of Devonport Tasmanian Open

OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP - MEN

Malaysia/Brisbane's Bryan Lim was crowned the 2020 City of Devonport Tasmanian Open Men's Champion ([see the 2020 Gallery Page for a photo](#)) when he defeated fellow Queenslander and reigning Australian National Champion Nick Calvert in the final.

Bryan and Nick went toe-to-toe in a five-star five-set classic. Top seed Bryan won the opening two games before second seed Calvert bunkered down and responded in style by taking out the next two.

Bryan swung the momentum back in his favour early in the fifth to build up his confidence and run over the top of Nick to win 11-6 and take the final in 56-minutes.

After taking the first game 12-10, David dropped the second to Brendan 9-11 before David powered home to win the third and fourth in close games and take the title.
